You can count on us to support you on this new journey as we count on you to make Amadora a City for everyone!



Portuguese public education is universal, compulsory and free of charge, covering students aged from 6 to 18 years old (Law No. 85/2009 of 27 August and Law No. 176/2012 of 2 August)


